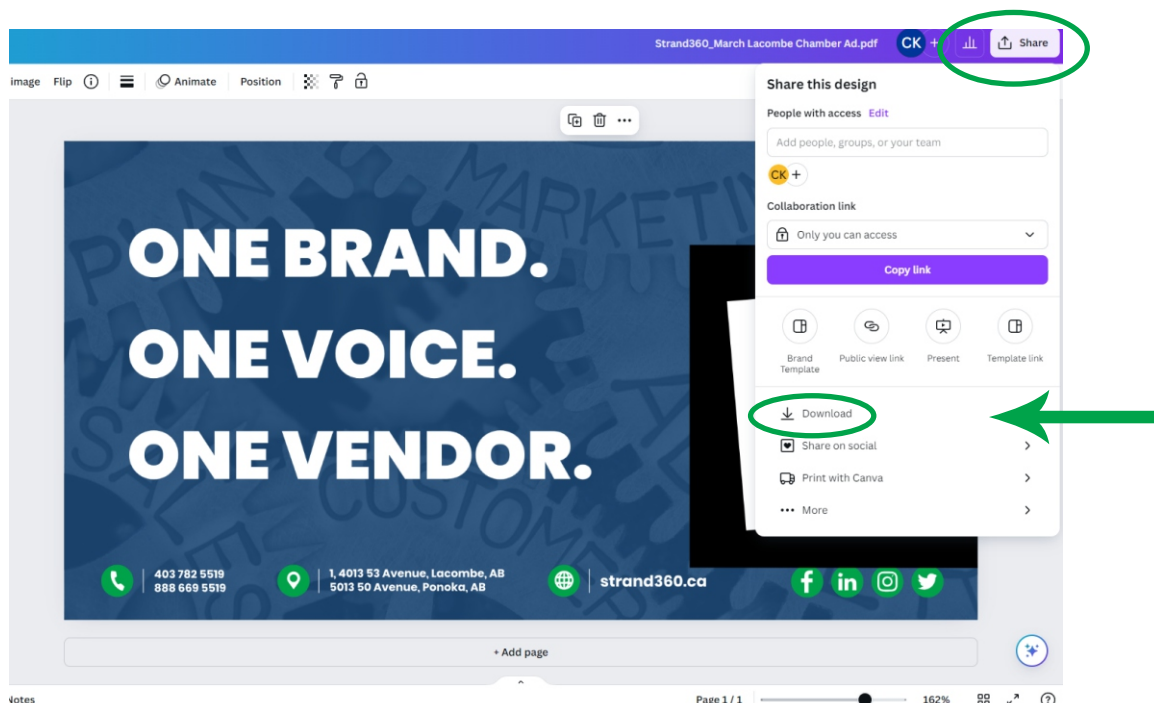


When submitting artwork designed in Canva to **Strand 360** we ask that you follow the following steps in order to ensure that your job is submitted as a **Press-Ready .PDF Artwork Files**.

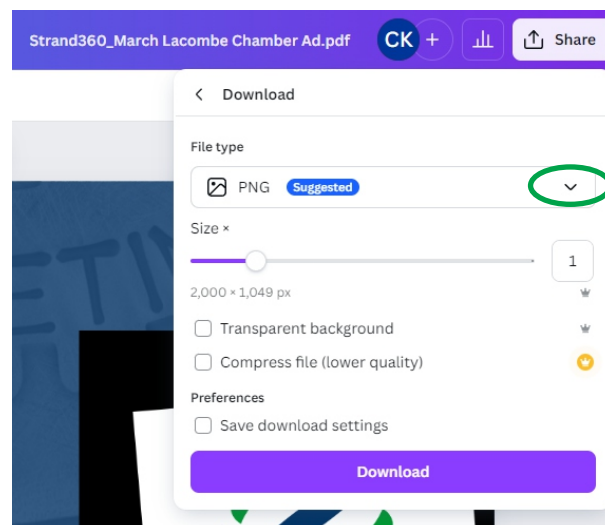
Step 1: Navigate to the Download Section

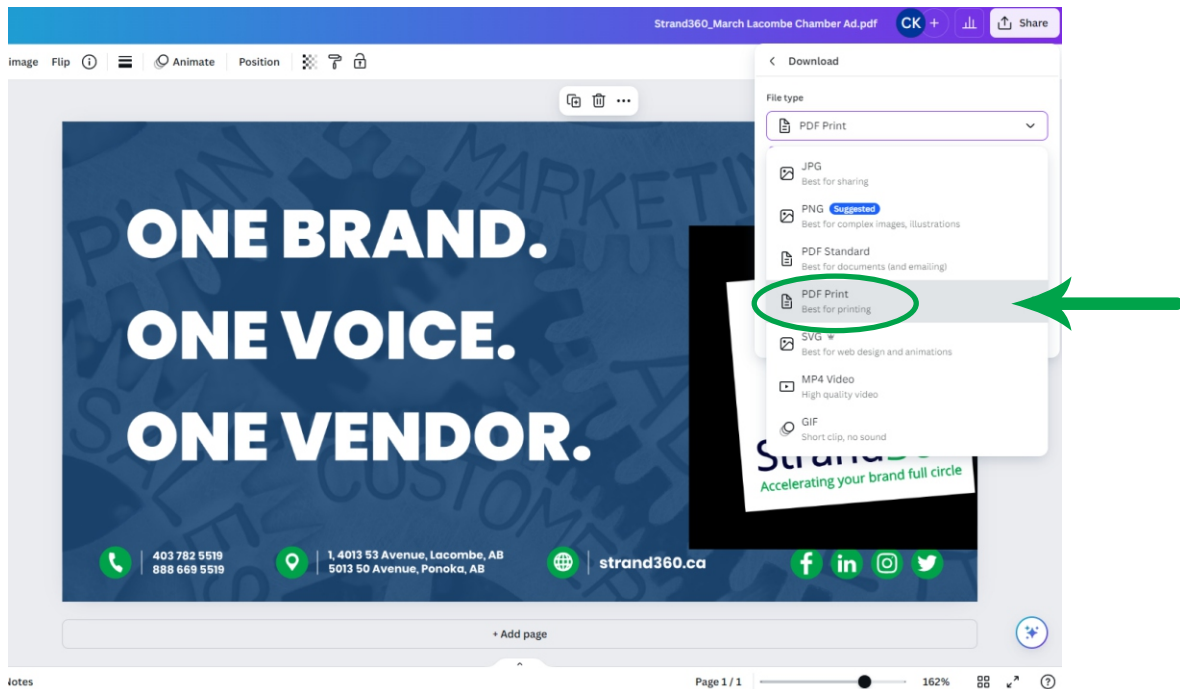
After your design is ready to go, the next step is to export your art. Click on the “Share” button in the top right of your screen. You will see the options in the image below. Select “Download”



Step 2: Change Your Export Settings

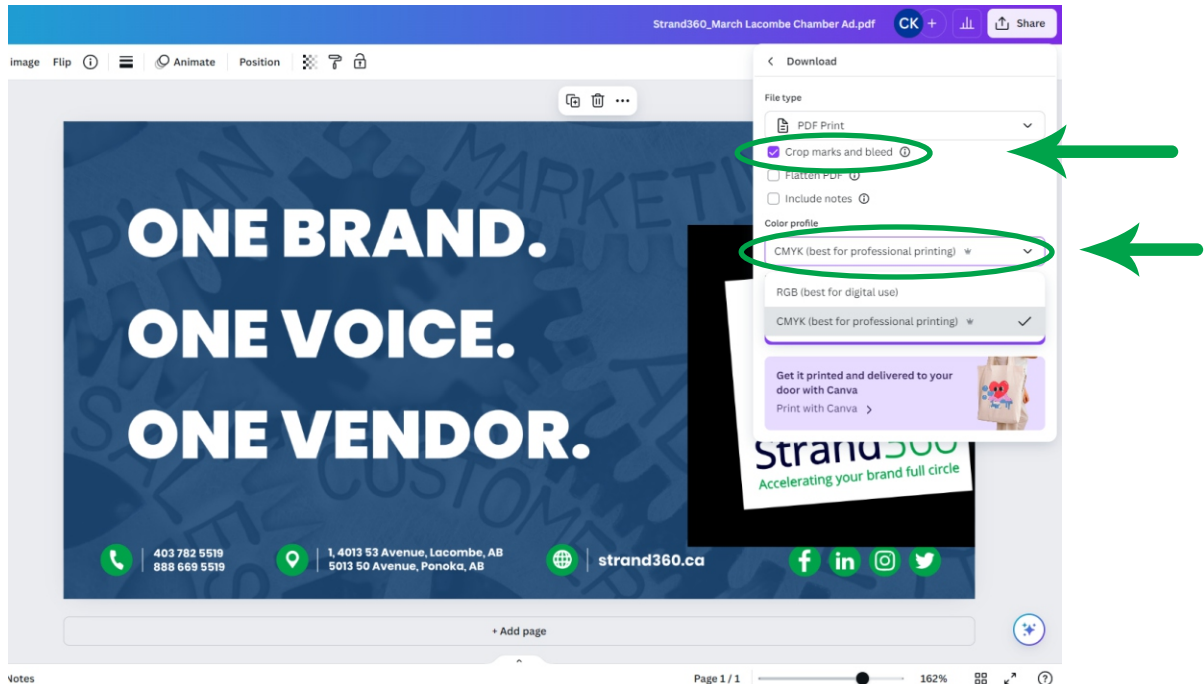
Your File Type setting will likely default to “PNG”. Make sure to click on PNG to see the rest of the options. This next step is the most important part: make sure your file type is “PDF Print.” Exporting as a PDF is the best option for print-ready artwork because it will keep the artwork editable, in the event that changes need to be made to it.





Step 3: Selecting Your PDF Print Options

In the “PDF Print” drop-down menu be sure to check off “Crop marks and bleed” in order to ensure the file is exported with the correct bleed and crop marks for printing, as well as to select the CMYK Color Profile for printing.



Step 4: Download Your Print-Ready File and Submit to Strand360

Once your settings are correct, that’s it! Just hit “Download,” and you’re ready to go! Submit your artwork to Strand360.
